Dear Governor Northam:

As the Senator representing the largest city in the Commonwealth, I am outraged by the disrespectful treatment extended toward the City of Virginia Beach, and specifically, our mayor. In a recent communication with Mayor Dyer and Virginia Beach City Council, your Chief of Staff Clark Mercer did not mince words. I can only hope he was acting unilaterally, as he is prone to do. Clark chastised our leadership for daring to criticize your rollout of the COVID-19 Vaccine—which by all accounts, has been nothing short of abysmal.

As of this weekend, Virginia is ranked 48th in the nation for getting the vaccines into the arms of our citizens. There is truly no excuse for this. You have blamed our president, our hospitals and our cities, when in fact other states have been widely successful under the same conditions. There was plenty of time to prepare. We have known for months that a vaccine was on its way. Why did you wait until a month into vaccinations to appoint a czar? That should have been done 6 months ago.
